Parade Participant Terms and Conditions

- All motorized vehicles must have and be prepared to present, upon request, a valid driver's license for the
 person driving, and a valid insurance card for the vehicle used. Any party(s) that does not comply, their entry
 may be forfeited as well as their fee. Governmental and First Responders are exempt from these
 requirements.
- 2. The owner/driver is solely responsible for damages caused to or by their vehicle.
- 3. Any Party not checked in with a Parade Coordinator by their assigned time, may forfeit their entry and fee.
- 4. All children in the parade must be accompanied by an adult.
- 5. All animals must be under physical control of an adult, who is immediately responsible for any clean-up necessary as a result of their animal.
- 6. Passing out treats or goods from a vehicle is prohibited, you must get out of the vehicle to do so, walking along with it, and pass out by hand (no tossing) for the safety of the children excited to receive them.
- 7. By participating in the Gleneden Beach 4th of July Parade, you agree to adhere to all event guidelines, rules and regulations as outlined by the organizing committee. This includes maintaining a safe and respectful environment for all participants and attendees, following the designated parade route, and complying with any instructions provided by event staff.
- 8. All submissions are subject to review and the organizing committee reserves the right to approve or deny applications based on event capacity, appropriateness, and alignment with the parade's values. If payment is required, it will be processed securely via Stripe, and you will receive a confirmation email upon successful registration.
