## Gleneden Beach Parade Participant Guidelines

It's that time to start planning the annual Gleneden Beach 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade. This year we are celebrating our 28<sup>th</sup> year and we invite you to be a part of it! This year's parade and street fair will take place on Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

## 1. Requirements:

- a. Pre-registration is required by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- b. All motorized vehicles must have and present for inspection a valid driver's license for the person driving, and a valid insurance card for the vehicle used. If you fail to provide this info, your entry will be forfeit as well as your fee. Governmental and First Responders are exempt from these requirements.
- c. The owner/driver is solely responsible for damages caused to or by their vehicle.
- d. Upon submitting your entry, you will be taken off-site to our secure Stripe credit card payment processor. After payment, you'll be sent a receipt with links to further information.
- e. Fee Schedule: General Entries \$10; Public Service Entries Free.

## 2. Day of the Parade:

- a. All parade participants will report where instructed (either at the Gleneden Beach Fire Station or Gleneden Beach State Park) to a Parade Coordinator the morning of the 4<sup>th</sup>.
- b. Check-in will begin at 11AM and needs be complete by 12:30PM. The Parade starts at 1PM.
- c. We will not be able to accommodate any late comers and you will forfeit your entry fee if you've not checked in with a Parade Coordinator by 12:30PM. The sooner you arrive the better.
- d. All children in the parade must be accompanied by an adult. No more than 4 kids per adult, unless corralled or within a vehicle.
- e. All animals must be under physical control of an adult, who is immediately responsible for feces clean-up. We recommend you have someone trailing directly behind to do this.
- f. All parade participants must keep up with the flow of the parade, and attempt to maintain the distances between that you started at.
- g. Passing out treats or goods from a vehicle is prohibited, you must get out of the vehicle to do so, walking along with it, and pass out by hand (no tossing) for the safety of the children excited to receive them.
